PSHE

Health and Wellbeing

The children will learn about staying safe and how to recognise and cope with good and not so good feelings.

French

The children will be learning about number to 20 and above using pocket money as hook.

Geography

Geography: Volcanoes

Children will learn what a volcano is before locating some of the world's most well-known volcanoes. They will describe where these volcanoes are in relation to the northern and southern hemispheres, and the equator. They will then use a variety of information sources to find out further facts about particular volcanoes. The children will explore why and how volcanos erupt by creating their own Holywell volcano.

Print and pattern.

The children will explore different printing methods before creating their own piece of Indian art for the School Fair.

Science

Magnets and Forces

Learn about the forces of attraction and repulsion between magnets, and about the force of attraction between magnets and magnetic materials. The children will carry out a range of scientific test to find answers to their own questions about magnets.

Hook/Focused experience:



The children will create a piece of Indian art to sell at the Christmas fair.

Numeracy

Addition and Subtraction: the children will continue to develop mental and written strategies for adding and subtracting. They will continue to use the column method as well as developing their estimating and reasoning skills.

Multiplication and Division: The children will continue to develop their knowledge of the times tables. They will also be writing and calculating statements for multiplication and division.

Music

The children continue to learn how to play the violin through songs, dance and using the violin. They will learn about rhythm and notation.

Literacy

Comic Strips:

The children will explore the features of comic strips and begin to look at speech. The will apply the spelling and grammar rules that they have learnt the previous term as well learning about subordinate clauses.

<u>Poetry: Poems to perform:</u> Year 3 will explore the poem 'The Magic Box' looking closely at the language used before writing their own free verse poem.
