PSHE

Relationships

The children will continue to recognise what is fair and unfair, kind and unkind, what is right and wrong. They will share their opinions on things that matter to them and explain their views through discussions. They identify and respect the differences and similarities between people and predict the consequences of their actions for themselves, other individuals or groups. The children will also be looking at relationships and challenging stereotypes.

Literacy

<u>Poetry:</u> The children will explore the poem the Magic Box before writing their own poem with a repeating pattern.

<u>Narrative</u>: Year 3 will explore the book 'Egyptian Cinderella'. They will plan and write their own story about the relationship between two key character using speech.

Science

Science: Rocks and Soils: The children will learn rocks are chosen for particular purposes because of their characteristics and beneath all surfaces there is rock. They will learn about the main types of rock and how they are formed. They will also learn there are different kinds of soil and this depends on the rock from which they come. We will be carrying out a number of investigations.

French

Unit 4

Mon Monstre (My Monster)

The children learn about the parts of the body and colours. They then use this knowledge to make their own monster.

History

Ancient Egypt

Year 3 will learn about the achievements of this ancient civilisation. They will learn about how and where the ancient Egyptians lived, what was important to the daily lives of ancient Egyptians, who Tutankhamun was and how mummies were made. The children will also learn about how Egyptian people used hieroglyphs to communicate and compare the powers of different gods

Art

Learn about the Post-Impressionist Artist: Paul Cezanne. The children will be looking at his work on landscapes and perspective. They will be developing their drawing skills by drawing landscapes using his style of work.

Hook/Focused experience:



Year 3 will explore how the Ancient Egyptians have helped us today through a series of fun and engaging lesson. They will study artefacts, make paper, canopic jars and shadufs to find out about the past and how the Ancient Egyptians lived.

Numeracy

Multiplication and Division

The children will develop their multiplication and division knowledge. This will include learning about the short written method for multiplication as well as deepening their understanding of the different strategies that can be used to divide.

Money

We will also look at money – converting between pounds and pence, adding and subtracting money and finally solving word problems.

Technology

<u>Pneumatics:</u> The children will be examining items that use air to make them move. They will then be designing, making and evaluating their own pneumatic device.

Internet Research:

Year 3 use the internet to search and find a range of information about Ancient Egypt. They continue to learn about using the internet safely.

<u>Christianity</u>: Jesus: The children will learn about the effect Jesus had on the people who met him.
