Opportunities and activities:

- P.E. lessons

Physical Literacy (Tuesday)

- Outdoor play, including climbing equipment, bats and balls and wheeled toys, loose parts to create our own obstacle courses.
- Using equipment safely.
- Funky Fingers to support fine motor.
- Change4life games.

Personal, Social and Emotional (Prime)
Development
Opportunities and activities:

- Explore the indoor and outdoor learning environments and choose a variety of activities, show interest in new activities.
- Encourage children to explore different areas of the classroom.
- Preparing for Year 1. Discussions with children regarding transition to Year 1. Visiting new class.

Communication and Language (Prime)
Opportunities and activities:

- Talk Boost
- Sharing news using tapestry.
- Helicopter stories
- Retelling stories, role play, circle time activities.

Literacy (Specific)
Opportunities and activities:
Book Focus: 'Giraffe's can't dance' 'Monkey Puzzle'

- Phase 3/4 Jolly phonics and letters and sounds daily phonics. Independent blending.
- Sorting real and alien words.
- ORT words and books.
- Retelling stories/ sequencing, role play, writing and drawing activities.
- Handwriting practice.
- Opportunities to write throughout all areas of the classroom.
- Encourage children to write independent helicopter stories.
- Create a fact-file of animals spotted in the jungle.

Mathematics (Specific)
Opportunities and activities:

- Number activities - recognising, ordering, counting, using numicon to support.
- Counting and measuring using natural materials.
- Early Maths Big Ideas
- Doubling, halving and sharing fruit and vegetables.
- Grouping and counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- Using 'messy maths' to develop maths in the outdoor area.
- Using tally chart to record during games.

Understanding the World (Specific)
