#### Debit Card Payments

At long last we have been able to secure a method for taking card payments for lunch money, trips, milk money etc with Northumberland County Council.

The system is now live and being used by a number of parents/carers. Feedback we are receiving is very positive.

There are very strict guidelines and remits which we must adhere to, one of which is that no card details can be retained for future payments.

Therefore, payments will need to be made either weekly (for lunch money) by either phoning the office/visiting in person.

OR

payments can be taken for monthly/termly amounts for ease.

We hope the introduction of this system will help busy
parents/carers.

Please note that after-school club fees will still only be accepted in either cheque or cash form. Premier Sport are unable to accept card/online payments at this time.
