### WEATHER ADVISEMENT











If the weather reports are to be believed, temperatures are set to drop next week, therefore we ask that all children come to school with suitable warm outdoor clothing each day.

Wherever possible, we will have the children outside at playtimes, lunchtimes and for PE sessions so it is essential that every child has jogging bottoms within their PE kit and a jumper/cardigan in school every day. The temperature within school is colder than normal as all windows are open in classrooms and communal areas for ventilation (as per Covid risk assessment and government instruction) so layering clothing is advisable. Should the snow come, we would love for the children to enjoy it on the field and they can only do this with suitable wellies or boots to wear outdoors. Please ensure that the children have an indoor change with them also.
