PARENT/TEACHER CONSULTATION APPOINTMENTS

Thank you to those of you who have already replied to the email sent on 04.11.20 requesting information and preferred appointment date and time information. If you have not replied, please do so by **Tuesday 10**th **November.** Anyone who has not replied by this date will be allocated a date and time by the class teacher.

As you are aware, parents/Carers will receive a ten minute call (these times will be strictly adhered to) on either 16th or 17th November between 3pm and 6pm.

Calls will come from a 'withheld' or 'private number' so please answer as we will not be making repeated attempts to contact due to time constraints.

- Please can we once again also ask all parents NOT to bring dogs to school especially into the pedestrian cut as this not only causes an obstruction but is issue for social distancing.
 - We are seeing an increased number of Potential accidents when Parents/carers are dropping off and picking up children.
