## **Important Weather Information**

Although the weather appears to be heading to improve and get a little warner, as you will no doubt have realised yourself in the most recent weeks, sometimes the forecasts get it entirely wrong! With this in mind, please can we ask that **ALL** children have a <u>waterproof warm coat</u>, <u>waterproof boots</u>, <u>hat and gloves</u> in school. Where possible we will always endeavour to get the children outside at playtime/dinnertime. However, should your child not be suitably attired for the weather they WILL NOT be given the opportunity (should it arise) to go outside. Please also be aware that school communal areas can get cold during temperature drops, so all children will need a sweatshirt or cardigan to wear whilst in school. We are expecting children to wear trousers or thick tights with skirts - no summer dresses or shorts should be worn when temperatures are low.
