Year Two - Monday and Wednesday

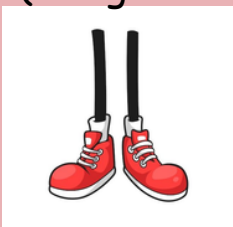
Year Three - Tuesday and Thursday

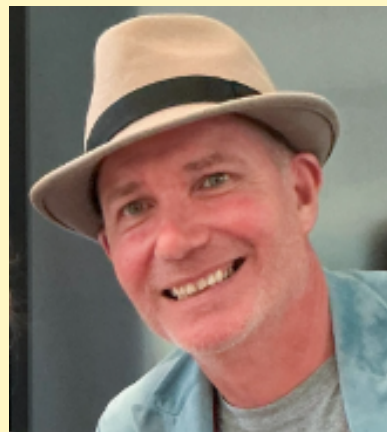
## World Book Day 2026

Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March - all reading Record Books are required in school for 9am.

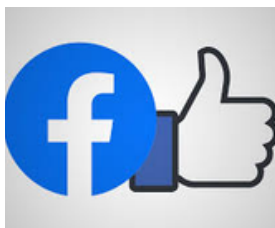
### Reading Awards Assembly:
